

General Gr 12 Information:

The following documentation is needed for Gr 12 registration:

- A **signed-off SACAI and Auxilio registration form**
- Legitimate **Gr 10 and 11 reports**, indicating that the candidate has completed the grades successfully, **or** proof of passing the Gr 12 entrance examination at a school/institution.
- For repeaters, a partly completed or complete **NSC (Umalusi) Certificate** or a previous statement of results must be attached as proof that the candidate has written the NSC before.
- As from January 2018 it will be **compulsory** for a candidate registering to write the NSC examination, to produce a **South African identity document** (excluding immigrant candidates with a valid study permit).

To do Gr 12 over 2 years:

- Learners may do Gr 12 over 2 years, but they may not write the supplementary exam in any subject during these 2 years.
- They will receive an Umalusi Subject Certificate and a Statement of Results at the end of each year, but it will not indicate the promotion status on either certificate.
- At the end of the 2 years, the candidate must apply to SACAI/Umalusi for the combination of these results, to determine the promotion status.

Learner's taking single subjects:

- Learners repeating failed subjects of the previous year, must redo the complete SBA.
- Learners repeating subjects they've passed, but would just like to improve their results, do not have to redo the complete SBA, they only need to write the Prelim and NSC exam for these subject/s.

Supplementary exam:

- Gr 12 - 2017 learners must apply directly to SACAI early January 2018, if they want to write the Supplementary exam. The Supplementary exam will be written during February/March 2018
- New legislation on the Supplementary exam will be implemented soon:

"SACAI recently received communication from the DBE that the Council of Education Ministers has endorsed the merging of the NSC Supplementary examination with the NSC Examination effect from 2019. For the DBE, this implies that candidates that would have written the Supplementary Examination in February/March 2019 can now write the Amended Senior Certificate Examination in June. The understanding is that the June examination will afford "open access" to learners that have failed to meet the requirements in the November examination, together with those that have passed but seek to improve their performance so that they may register to write the June examinations. It also needs to be noted that policy has not yet been amended to accommodate this change."

Re-mark procedure:

- Learners must apply directly to SACAI.

Outstanding Tasks/Absenteeism from exams:

- Should a Gr 12 not submit a task in any one of the subjects throughout the year OR be absent from an exam without a legal doctor's certificate, a 999 score will be given to such a Gr 12 learner. Resulting in an incomplete for this subject. This subject will have to be re-done the following year.
- Should a Gr 12 be absent from the June or Prelim exam with a legal doctor's certificate the year mark will be used as the mark for this exam.
